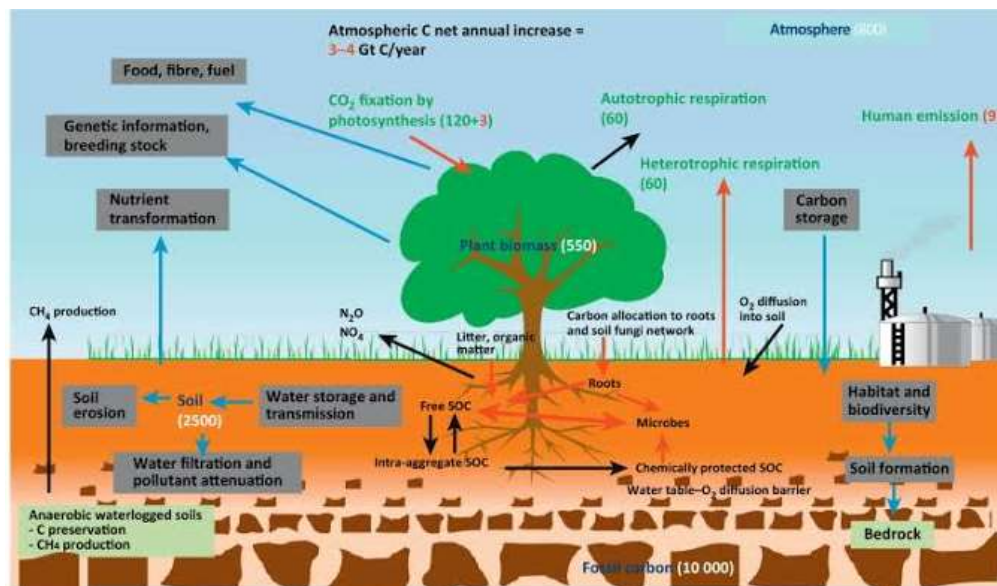


Soil Carbon - what is it all about?
