Tamie Weaver is a Senior Lecturer in hydrogeology at the University of Melbourne. She received her undergraduate training in geology in the US, and a Masters and PhD in hydrogeology in the US and Canada. Currently she coordinates the Hydrogeology stream of the Master of Environment and has several PhD and Honours students working on controls on aquifer quality and chemistry, as well as controls on groundwater salinisation.
