In this role your current focus will be on ensuring the delivery of outcomes aligned with year 3 and 4 of the Environmental Contributions funding to achieve the required funding outcomes and alignment with the Regional Catchment Strategy. This will involve:

- Identify, plan and implement projects in partnership with internal and external stakeholders including investigations into ecological responses to environmental water deliveries.
- Collaborate and negotiate with stakeholders including the Victorian Environmental Water Holder, the Commonwealth Environmental Water Office and Traditional Owner groups to achieve and maximise environmental water management outcomes.
- Contribute to the planning, management and monitoring of environmental water across the region. Waterways that receive environmental water include the Broken River, Broken Creek, Goulburn River and ten wetlands.
- Support and coordinate effective communication and engagement with key stakeholders to build knowledge in and support for environmental water management. Working with the Manager to provide input into regional, State and Federal plans, strategies and policies including the Goulburn to Murray Trade Rule and the Victorian Waterway Management Strategy.
- Identify and contribute to funding opportunities.
- Lead the delivery of other projects and tasks as required.

You will bring with you:

- Expertise in current waterway policy and river health management practices;
- Demonstrated knowledge, experience and skills in the successful delivery of water related on-ground works projects
- Demonstrated understanding of State and regional water policies, strategies and legislation as it relates to waterway management

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
