## Community NRM Awards

#### **Community Education Award**

This award will be presented to a community group, primary or secondary school or youth group – either as a whole class or special group. The award is for the contribution to raising an understanding of the Landcare ethic amongst students and / or the community, and for implementing Landcare practices on their own property or within the local community.

#### Community Sustainable Farming Award

This award will be presented to a primary producer or enterprise (i.e. an agricultural co-operative, network, agricultural industry association, research group, private business or primary producer) involved in primary production who implements innovative practices or activities to improve natural resource management and productivity outcomes.

**Community Group Award** 

This award will be presented to an outstanding community group that has adopted best management practices on public or private land and is working towards enhancing or protecting an area on behalf of the community.

#### **Community Network Award**
